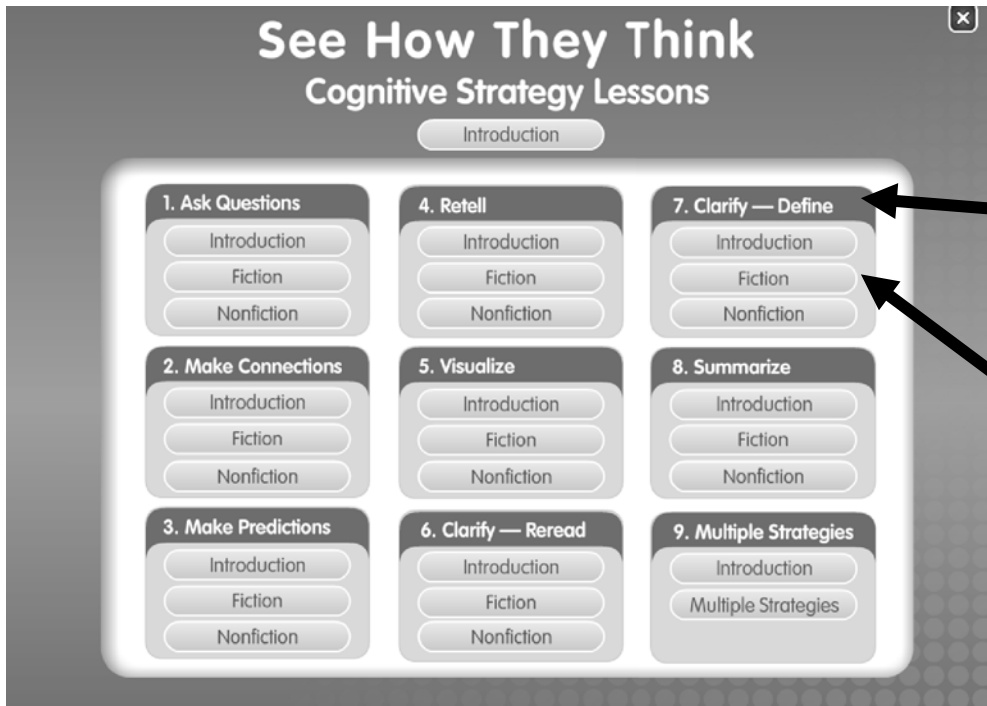

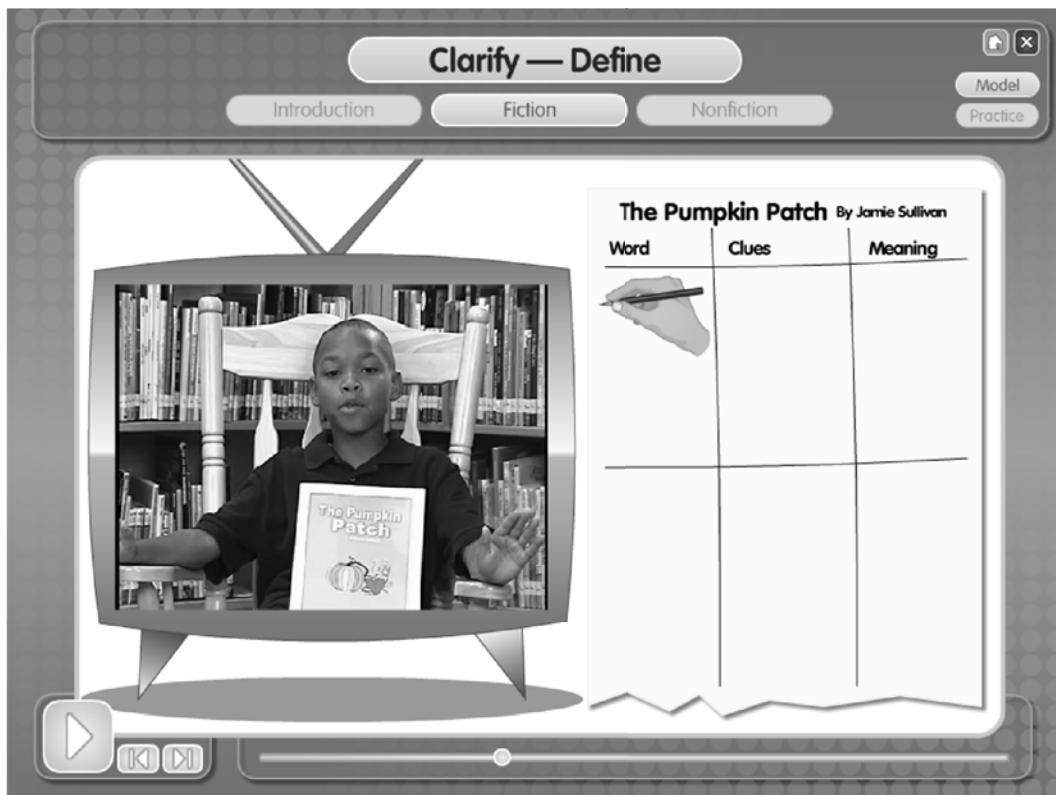

The Main Menu screen allows the teacher to choose a specific strategy. Under each strategy the teacher can choose to play the strategy introduction or the modeling and guided practice for a fiction text or nonfiction text.

Once the strategy is selected, the teacher can choose to play the introduction to the strategy. In this brief video, students will learn the strategy name, definition, when to use the strategy, and why the strategy is important to readers. The teacher can display the corresponding strategy definition charts found in this guide during the introduction.





Under each strategy there is an option of fiction or nonfiction text. Once selected, students will watch a brief model (think-aloud) targeting the strategy. Students will watch and listen to a reader use the strategy as his thoughts are charted on a graphic organizer.

After the model video, the teacher can select to play a guided practice video. Each guided practice activity provides students with an interactive opportunity to practice the strategy within a text provided on the screen. The teacher can choose to read the text aloud or have students read from the screen. The teacher knows to advance the practice when the play button blinks. The teacher can use the strategy graphic organizers found in this guide to chart student responses during the guided practice activity.
